## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Tena koutou,

Well, here we are again in Level 2. It is pleasing to see how New Zealanders are responding to this latest outbreak, and we're hopeful that it won't last for too long.

While most of us are familiar with requirements at Alert Level 2, here at Waipu Primary School we will continue to emphasise the importance of:

- Good hand hygiene and cough and sneeze etiquette
- Staying away if sick
- Keeping the appropriate physical distance from others
- Cleaning and disinfecting our high touch surfaces daily
- Displaying QR code posters at our entrances and encouraging all of our community to download the NZ COVID Tracer App and use it if they come on-site
- Keeping a visitor register for anyone who cannot use the app and for other essential visitors
- Waiting at the Argyle St entrance for children in the afternoon rather than coming into school for end of day pick-up.
- Minimising the changes to bus travel to essential changes only.

We know all these things will help to keep our community as safe as possible. Thank you for your continued support for all we are doing to keep our community safe.

This term, you will notice that all classes are working on 'Change' as a focus for their Social Studies inquiry. Senior classes visited MOTAT last week and this week and next, Junior classes

are visiting 'Kiwi North' Museum in Whangarei. (Our focus in the first half of the year was change associated with Science). As a school, we are reviewing our Science and Social Science (studies) curriculum and we have been fortunate to have a facilitator from Cognition Education bringing us up to speed with the capabilities children will need to have in these two curriculum domains. In Science, there used to be a focus on living world, material world, physical world and planet earth and beyond. Now the focus is more on 'The Nature of Science' e.g. how to gather and interpret information, use and critique evidence and to engage with science across all the science 'worlds'. Similarly in Social Science, we now focus on identifying our own and other's values, investigating ways in which groups contribute to their community, know about their own and the traditions of groups, tell stories about what happened in the past and lastly, how people can impact a place. In both of these curriculum areas, there is also a focus on exploring the local curriculum – what we have around us in our own community to value and learn about. Curriculum review in any educational institution, is an ongoing process as we all work to prepare our tamariki for their futures.
