## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia ora koutou

Welcome to Term 4 – a term that promises to fly by, not only because it is slightly shorter than our usual term of ten weeks, but also because it will be busy. Camps, Floral and Ag Day, a stage show, tennis coaching, water safety, Life Education and two visiting shows are just a few of the activities that we have planned for the term.

A couple of weeks ago, we welcomed Auckland moving to Level 1 which has eased movements for us for camps in Week 5. We do remind parents of the three key actions that still need to be observed:

- If your child is in any way, unwell, keep them home.
- Continue to use our QR code when visiting the school
- Continue to use safe hygiene practices – hand washing, appropriate sneezing and coughing etiquette and disinfecting surfaces.

We will continue to reinforce these same practices at school.

Once the draft strategic plan for 2021-2023 is ready (hopefully by the end of November), that will also be available for comment before it is officially adopted by the Board of Trustees.

### FLORAL DAY - Friday 16th October

The day before Agricultural Day is Floral Day. Children have most of the morning to create floral/craft displays. A schedule of items children are to create has been sent home. Parents are welcome to help children in the Junior Team on the day, and offer advice to those in the Senior Team. If you don't have many flowers at home, don't worry as there are always heaps that come in, and Waipu children are good at sharing. Rooms 1,2,3,4,10 & 11 please bring your baked goodies along to the Workshop and Rooms 6,7,8 & 9 to the old Room 10 (next to the Workshop) on Agricultural Day (Sat 17th Oct). Baking will be judged in the morning and can be viewed after animals have been judged.

## **AGRICULTURAL DAY - Saturday 17th October**

This will be the last newsletter before Ag day. Please remember your child/ren will need to be at school early enough to drop their baking into the Workshop (for Rooms 1,2,3,4,10 & 11) and old Room 10, next to the Workshop (for Rooms 6,7,8 & 9) and for the roll to be taken at 8.30am. Please also bear in mind there is often quite a congestion at the baking drop off points. If children do not have an animal they are expected to stay until the end of the day and support their peers who have made the effort to bring an animal. The following times are approximate as they are dependent on the time it takes the judges to do their job and the results to be collated for trophies.

### **Programme**

- **8.00am** - Animal registration on the back field (please look for Mrs Andrews).
- **8.30am** - School roll taken in the Northpine Hall.
- **9.00am** - Animal judging starts and usually finishes about 11am.
- **11.00am** - Year 6 games start for those with bands. Presales will be available on Ag Day at the Y6 baking food stall from 8.30am and then at the gate to the games from 11am. The Y6 children will have some fun activities to keep everyone occupied. These activities are to raise money for their camp at Hunua. All classrooms will be open for viewing of floral day entries. The workshop will be open for children and visitors to view the baking results and the silent auction will start for Year 6 cakes.
- **12.30-1pm (approx)** - We will hold prizegiving and the cake auction for the top Year 6 winning cakes. We're expecting some sensational cakes from our year 6 Fathers this year - prepare to be wowed! All proceeds will go towards the Year 6 camp.
- **1.30pm (approx)** - Parents may take their children, baking and floral work home once the auction is finished. A programme will be sent home this week.
