PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia ora koutou

On Tuesday, staff began the process of placing children in classes for 2021. This is a well considered process as teachers base their decision on factors such as social maturity, academic ability, gender balance of the class, behavioural factors, friendships, learning needs and amount of time in the junior school (As a general rule children with birthdays after the end of March will spend the remainder of that year and two more years in the Year 1 and 2 classes. Studies show that this is more beneficial than pushing them through to the next class level). We try to do our best for each child and we will consider your requests and address any concerns you may have. However in the end, it is the school's decision as to where your child will be placed. Historically, this process has worked very well even though at times, some caregivers' may hold a different opinion.

In all classes, children are taught at the level they are at – e.g. reading/maths material will be at the child's level, whatever class they are in. Due to year group numbers, mixed year classes are unavoidable but they do provide us more flexibility with placement.

If you have any concerns about the placement of your child, please make a time to see me or give me a call prior to Friday, November 20. If I don't hear from you before then, there will be minimal chance of us being able to make a change. I will do my best to accommodate your requests but make no promises.

You will find out your child's placement and teacher before the end of the year.

On another note, the Board of Trustees have recently reviewed our school's Bullying Procedures and have formulated guidelines for staff so that they can better recognise and

manage Bullying in our school. We recognise, that at times, bullying will occur but we are now confident that we have the processes in place to deal with this behaviour, should it occur. These two documents are now available on our website under 'Parent Information'.
