Kia ora koutou,

This term is slipping by quite quickly as we become conscious of all that we need to complete in the next few weeks.

Teachers are busy with assessments at the moment – getting ready for mid-year reporting to parents early in Term 3.

Robinson's Asphalt have moved on site to begin work on the driveway. Thank you to all parents for your co-operation and patience as we work through this disruption. All has gone well so far and we appreciate those of you who have moved your children on to buses to lessen the congestion in the carpark.

All classes have also been involved in learning about the History of Waipu, and with this being the time for senior's speech writing – some have chosen to focus on this topic in their speeches.

The Matariki Festival is also on our school agenda for the end of the term. The Kapa Haka groups are sounding hauntingly beautiful and quite fearsome as they refine their performance at practices.

Te Arahi
