Compulsory School Uniform Hat - Term 1 2021

It is **compulsory** for all children to wear a hat at morning tea and lunchtimes, during the warmer months of Term 1 and Term 4. Full brimmed school hats are now part of our school uniform and are usually available online [click here](#) or at The Warehouse (Whangarei) for \$20 each. However we have been advised by Schooltex that they are not currently available but more hats are at the embroiders and sizes will be fully stocked again soon (along with other items of our school uniform). Students may wear alternate suitable hats in the meantime. These hats will be compulsory for Years 1-5 **Term 4 2021**. Year 6 students will still need a full brimmed hat but the Schooltex hat will not be compulsory for them.

If students do not have a hat they will be required to play under the shade shelter.

Incredible Years Parenting Programme

On the 23rd March 2021 through to 6th July, Family Works Whangarei will be facilitating a 14 week Incredible Years parenting programme in Maungaturoto at the Maungaturoto Centennial Hall. This programme is going to be held every Tuesday starting at 10.00am – 12.30pm. The programme won't be ran in the school holidays.

The Incredible Years programme is a parenting programme for parents/caregivers that have children between the ages of 3 and 8 years old.

- Gain skills to feel more confident about their parenting
- Have positive and nurturing parenting styles

- Using rewards to motivate Tamariki/children
- How to set limits with your Tamariki/children
- How to handle misbehaviour
- Ignoring, distractions, redirects, warnings
- Time out for aggressive behaviour
- Logical and natural consequences
- Creative problem solving
- How to play with your tamaiti/child
- The value of effective praise
- Using rewards to motivate Tamariki/children
- How to set limits with your Tamariki/children
- How to handle misbehaviour
- Ignoring, distractions, redirects, warnings
- Time out for aggressive behaviour
- Logical and natural consequences
- Creative problem solving

Morning tea will be provided and after 14 weeks there will be a graduation celebration.
