PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia ora koutou,

We've had a great start to the second term with all classes being involved in the Health topic of Road Safety. We appreciate the support of the NZ Police in helping us to get the important safety messages through to the children.

Just a reminder to everybody that the school's strategic plan for 2021 – 2023, is available on the school website. This is a guiding document for our school and was developed following the Community consultation, held in Term 3 last year.

Within the plan, you should be able to see direct links to what is happening within the school. Initiatives like 'Accelerated Literacy Learning', 'Positive Behaviour for Learning' (PB4L), 'Gifted and Talented' programmes, 'Play based learning', and integration of the 'Local Curriculum' are all visible in the plan and are underway in our current school programmes.

On Monday, Moana Emett, Positive Behaviour for Learning Restorative Practice - Professional Leader / Accredited Facilitator, will be at school to run a meeting for parents and whanau on Restorative Practice.

The meeting will run from 5 – 6.00 p.m. and will be held in the staffroom. You are most welcome to bring children along, they will be able to watch a movie in Kōtuku (Room 1) while the parents are in the meeting. Refreshments will be available.

Moana will be sharing the key features, principles, and benefits of the restorative approach and outlining ways in which you can support what we do here at school, in the home environment.

Please come along and ask questions, share opinions and learn some new strategies to manage behaviours at home.

Remember also, that there is a short survey – to which you would have been emailed a link, asking about how you prefer to be reported to, about your child's progress. Please complete this survey by Friday so that we can evaluate the results before mid-year reporting.
